SEATING

Before and after a performance please ask all band members to observe the competition from the bleachers on the NORTH (visitor's) side of the field.

SERVICES

- School busses will enter at the east entrance of the south parking lot off West End Avenue by the tennis courts and will be directed by an attendant to the parking position.
- Visitor entrance and parking will be available north of the school.
- Restrooms & Porta Pots are located west of the grandstand. Handicap restrooms are available in the high school.
- Food and refreshments will be available at very reasonable prices. A menu is enclosed. Concessions are located on the east end of the grandstands. We encourage the bands and fans to stay at the competition to enjoy the performances of all bands.
- Guides will be waiting to greet your band, guide you in each area of the staging schedule, and stay with you until your performance to help you in any way. A schedule is enclosed for your convenience. The 15 minute interval schedule makes it imperative that all bands be at

the designated areas at the appropriate time. Students and chaperones will have their hands marked as students disembark from the busses. Please have students stay on the bus until their hands have been marked. The wristbands that are needed to enter to watch the competition will be available for fans to purchase at the north entrance.

EQUIPMENT

Newton will not haul the pit equipment. There are a few rules to follow:

1. No small-wheeled pit equipment will be allowed on the track. Protective belting will be across the track at your entrance and exit. If there are other props and equipment needed on the field, please cross where the belting covers the track. The belting cannot be moved down the track.
2. No equipment is to be taken to the field entrance until your assigned time.

RAIN INFORMATION

In the event of rain, the competition will not be moved inside. If rain is excessive, the competition will be canceled.

AWARDS PRESENTATION

All drum majors will assemble on the field for the awards ceremony immediately following the exhibition performance by the Newton Marching Eagles.
